The Associate of Arts Degree may be earned upon the satisfactory completion of 64 credit hours consisting of 26 hours of Bible and Theology, 20 hours of general education, and 18 hours of departmental studies.

This program is a 6-course, modular program that is designed to provide guidelines for administering an educational ministry in the local church.


