



## ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Seminary applicants must also have received their Bachelor's degree and submit a transcript indicating that the Bachelor's degree has been conferred on the applicant by an acceptable four-year college.

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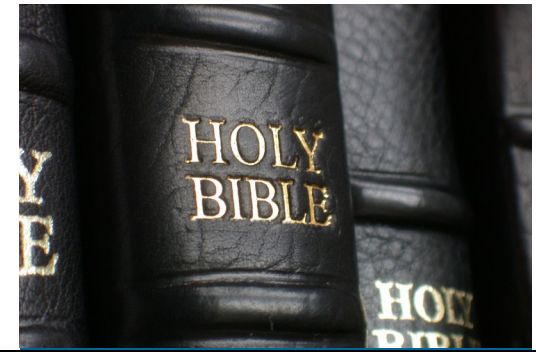

## SEMINARY PURPOSE

Today more than ever, it is increasingly important to continue personal and professional growth to better serve the Lord and humanity in an educated society.

The overall mission of the Seminary Division is to provide quality, rigorous academic study for experienced Christian professionals. ## MASTER OF CHRISTIAN MINISTRY DEGREE

### PURPOSE

The Master of Christian Ministry Degree (M.C.M.) program is designed to provide students with a biblical and theological foundation for godly living and fruitful Christian ministry. The program is offered to assist students in gaining additional theological training while they are serving in their local church. To allow for maximum application of the courses, it is therefore required that applicants be active in ministry in their local church.

### WHY THE M.C.M. PROGRAM?

The Master of Christian Ministry Degree prepares students for practical areas of ministry, such as local church ministry, evangelism, church planting, Christian education, and Christian leadership. It equips students with skills in leadership, communication, and counseling. As well, the program gives assessment tools to relate to particular ministry contexts.

### PROGRAM CURRICULUM

The Master of Christian Ministry Degree program has a 36-hour curriculum designed to enable anyone in vocational Christian ministry to increase their competence and degree of excellence while not abandoning their current ministry.

## LEARNING OUTCOMES

Graduates of this program will be able to:

- Offer a credible defense of sound doctrine,
- Integrate a greater understanding of Scripture into various ministry contexts,
- Evaluate current issues affecting ministry in light of biblical teaching, and
- Demonstrate the ability to apply the Word of God practically in their area of ministry through research and writing projects.
